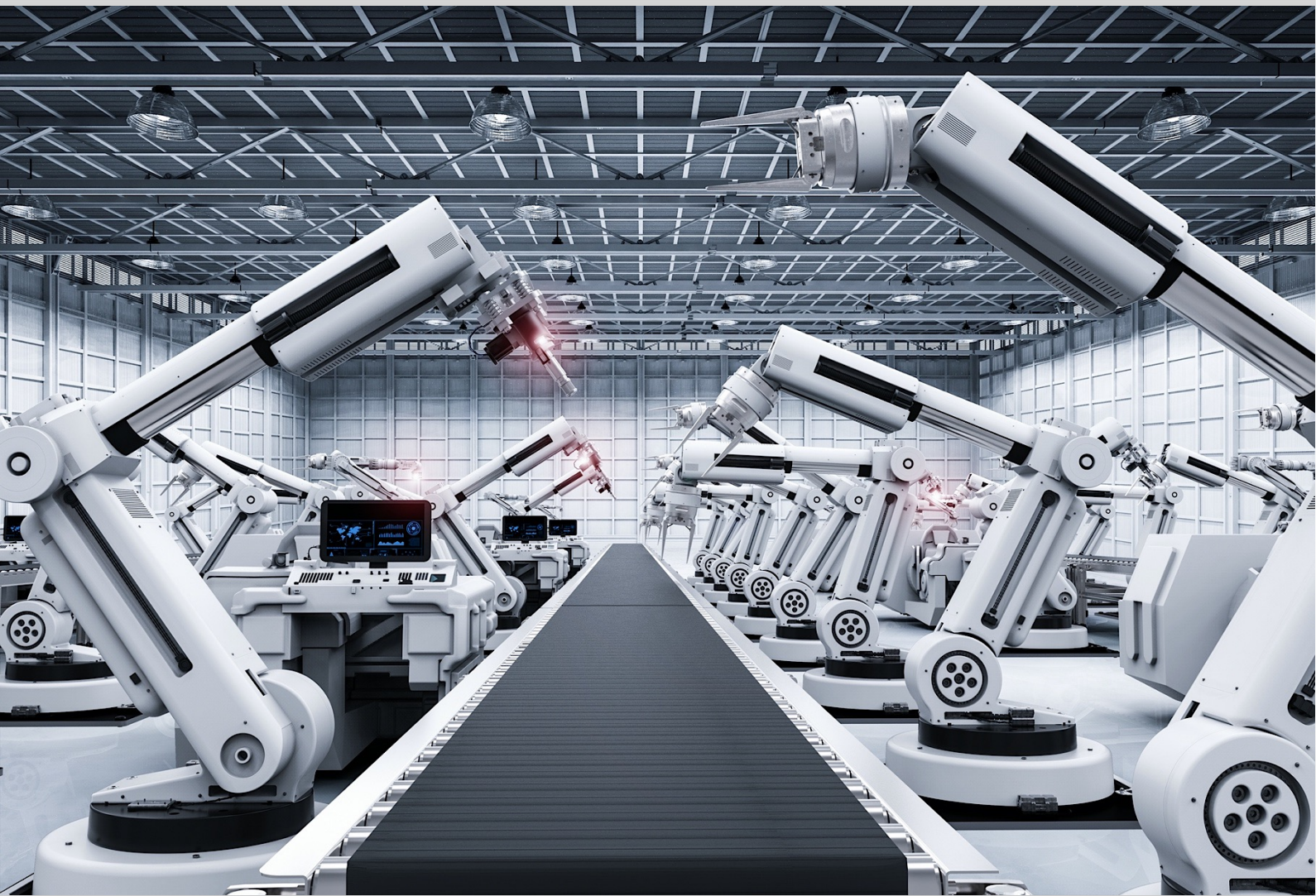

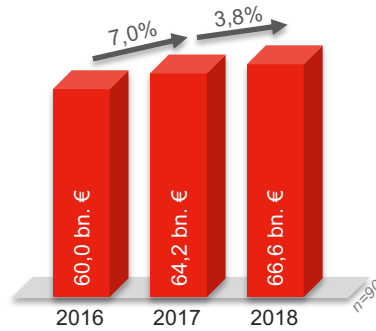

Sales performance of the TOP 100 Mechanical Engineering Companies

Only companies for which data were available from all three years were included in the calculation.

At 3.8%, the German TOP 100 Mechanical Engineering Companies grew faster in 2018 than the mechanical engineering market as a whole (2.8%, VDMA) and also faster than the German economy (1.5%, Destatis).

Compared with 2017, however, growth in the TOP 100 slowed significantly. In 2017, the sales growth of the largest mechanical engineering companies was again higher than that of the sector (5.4%, VDMA) and the German economy as a whole (2.5%, Destatis).



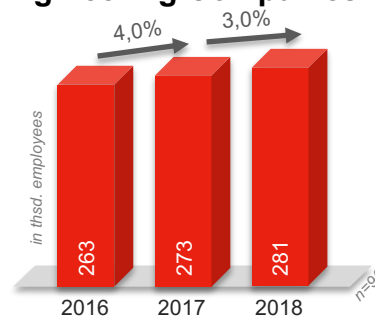
TOP 100 Mechanical Engineering companies grew by 3.8% in 2018 and generated total sales of just under €67 billion

Only companies for which data were available from all three years were included in the calculation.

The number of employees at the TOP 100 companies rose by 3.0% to around 281,000 in 2018, roughly in line with the industry trend (+3.2%, VDMA).

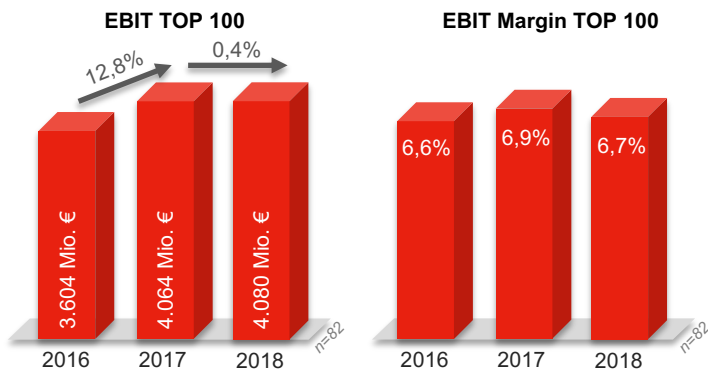
In the previous year, the number of employees at Germany's largest mechanical engineering companies grew by 4.0% (from 263,000 to 273,000), faster than the industry as a whole (+1.4%, VDMA).

Only companies for which data were available from all three years were included in the calculation.



After a significant increase in EBIT to over €4 billion in 2017, there was a sideways movement in 2018 with growth of 0.4%.

At 6.7%, the EBIT margin in 2018 was below the prior-year figure of 6.9% but above the level of 2016 (6.6%).

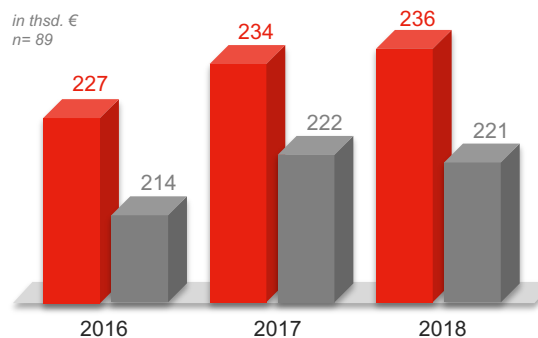
EBIT of the TOP 100 companies increased by 0.4% in 2018 to a total of over €4 billion. The EBIT margin was 6.7%.

Labor productivity of the TOP 100 compared with the industry as a whole

Only companies for which data were available from all three years were included in the calculation.

In 2018, the TOP 100 Mechanical Engineering Companies in Germany increased their sales per employee by 0.8%, while labor productivity in the sector fell by 0.5% in the same period.

In the previous year, the growth in labor productivity of the TOP 100 companies of 2.8% was still below the average growth within the industry (3.7%).



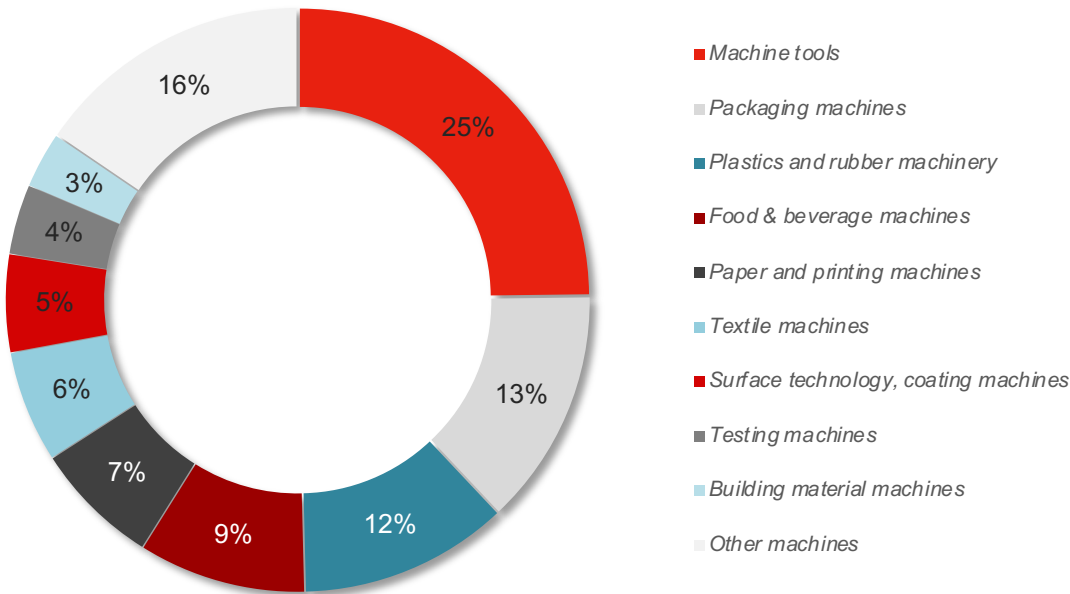
Productivity of TOP 100 mechanical engineering companies above sector average at €236 thousand sales per employee

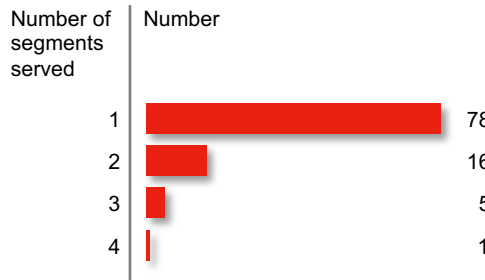
Product portfolio of the TOP 100 Mechanical Engineering Companies

Every fourth TOP 100 company builds machine tools. Another 25% manufacture packaging or plastics and rubber machinery.

Every fourth TOP 100 company produced machine tools in 2018. Another 25% produced packaging and/or plastics and rubber machinery. Most machine builders specialized in one type of machine (78%). Three or more product segments were served by only 6% of the TOP 100.



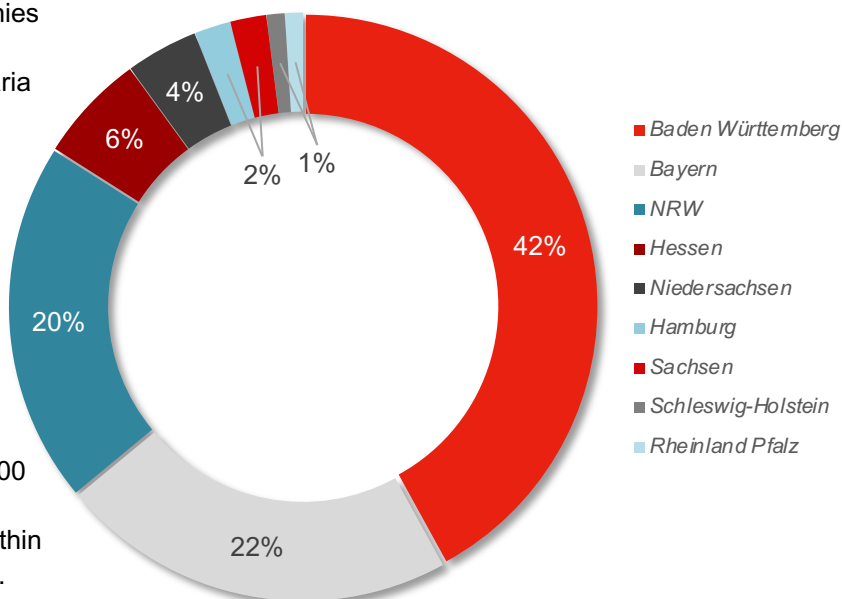
Almost 80% of the TOP 100 specialize in one segment

84 of the TOP 100 companies have their headquarters in Baden-Württemberg, Bavaria or NRW.

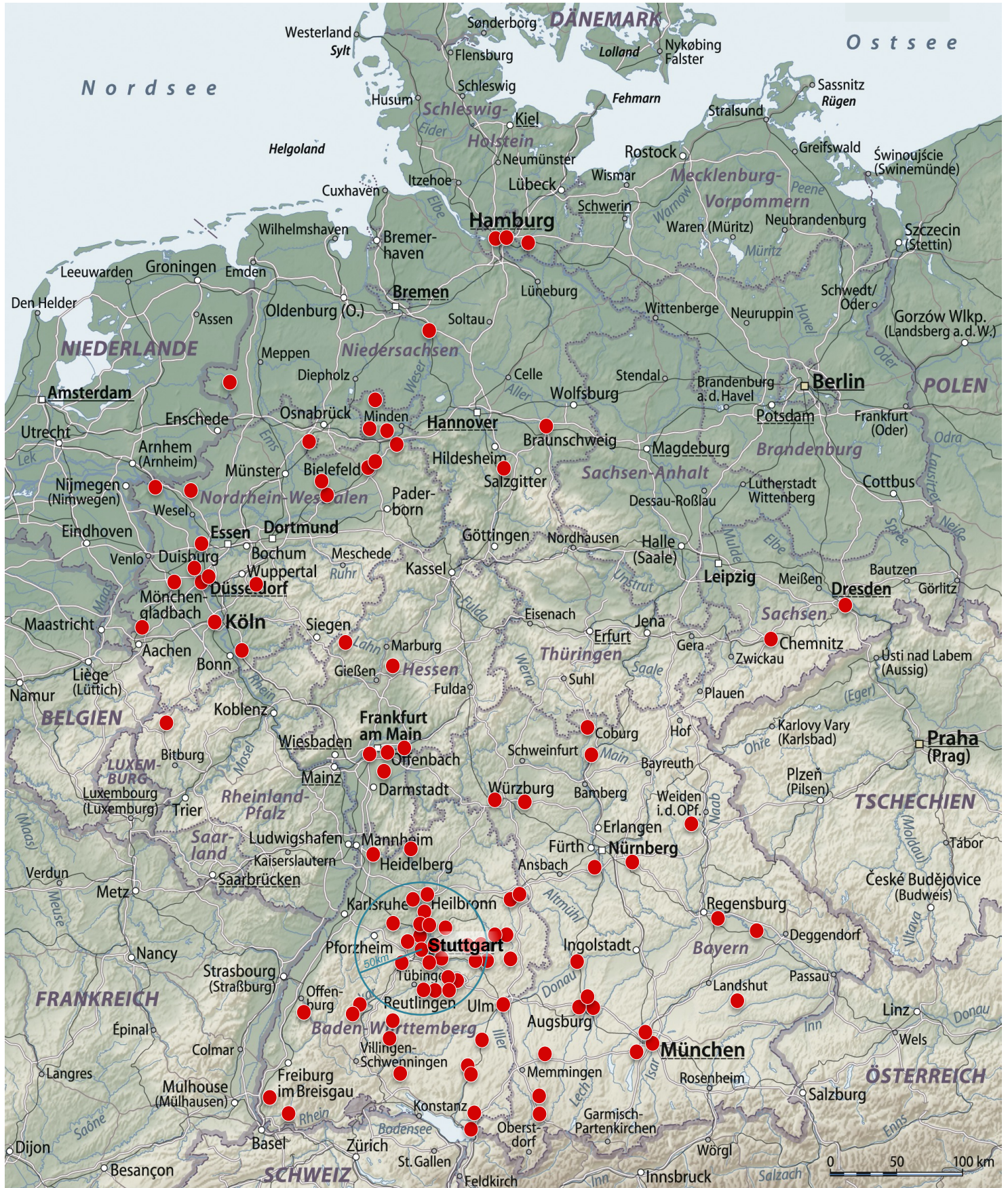

Comments on the study: TOP 100 Mechanical Engineering Companies in Germany

General

- The study took into account companies that
 - develop or produce machines for industrial manufacturing processes and
 - have a production or development site in Germany.
- The following, for example, are not included
 - Companies that are predominantly active in plant engineering (Siemens, Thyssenkrupp)
 - Manufacturers of mainly or exclusively agricultural machinery (AGCO, Deutz, John Deere)
 - Manufacturers of machine components such as pumps, compressors, drives or similar (Wilo, Kaeser, Festo, SKF)
 - Engine manufacturers (MAN, FEV, MTU)
- The key sales figures of the entire company from 2018 are decisive for the ranking.

Comments on the product categorization

- Packaging machines (e.g. packaging and filling machines)
- Machine tools (e.g. lathes, milling and grinding machines, woodworking machines, assembly tables, presses)
- Building material machines (e.g. building material production machines, glass production machines)
- Food & beverage machines (e.g. bakery machines, refining machines, cigarette production machines, sausage, meat and cheese processing machines, centrifuges, stirring machines)
- Textile machines (e.g. industrial sewing machines, CNC sewing machines)
- Paper and printing machines (e.g. paper machines, corrugating rolls, corrugating machines, printing machines)
- Plastics and rubber machinery (e.g. extruders, injection molding machines)
- Surface technology, coating machines (e.g. machines for coating, painting machines)
- Testing machines (e.g. material and workpiece testing machines, quality control machines)
- Other machines (e.g. winding machines, machines for wafer and semiconductor production, palletizing systems, strapping machines, wire drawing machines, machines for metal production, mixer granulating machines, stirring machines, machines for heat & air conditioning technology, dosing systems, automatic placement machines)
